

The training center we started in Manila has been formally recognized by an association of schools called The Master's Academy International (www.tmainternational.org), a seminary planting movement started by graduates of The Master's Seminary. Our school in The Philippines will be the seventeenth TMAI school around the world. As a TMAI school, we have access to resources from The Master's Seminary, Grace Community Church, and other TMAI training centers. We also have instant credibility from the Filipino pastors who have respect for John MacArthur, Grace to You, and The Masters Seminary. It has only been a few weeks since our TMAI affiliation was announced, but already we have received several emails from pastors in the Philippines who would like to be trained in our center.
